

#### **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTONS**

- 1. Lift the front of the vehicle up using a jack . Place jack stands under the frame and lower the vehicle.
- 2. Remove the front wheels and tires.
- 3. Remove the ABS line from the (2) clips on the upper sway link mount and the lower strut mount. See Photo 1.
- 4. Remove the sway link nut using an 18mm socket. Remove the sway link from the strut mount bracket. See Photo 2.






- 5. Loosen the (2) lower strut nuts using a 18mm wrench and socket. See Photo 3. NOTE: Do not remove the nuts from the bolt.
- 6. Support the lower control arm using a jack. Use a hammer to press the (2) studs from the knuckle and lower strut mount. Hit the nut only. **See Photo 4.**





- 7. Lower the jack and remove the knuckle from the strut. See Photo 5.
- 8. Support the strut and remove the (2) upper strut bolts using a 13mm socket. See Photo 6.








- 9. Remove the strut from the vehicle. See Photo 7.
- 10. Locate the new loaded lift strut. See Photo 8.







- 11. Install the strut into the upper strut mount of the vehicle. See Photo 9.
- 12. Secure the strut using (2) of the supplied bolts. Hand tighten the bolts only at this time. See Photo 10.





- 13. Raise the control arm up and place the knuckle into the lower strut mount using the jack. Secure the strut using the OE hardware. Install the bolts from the back to the front. **See Photo 11.**
- 14. Tighten the (2) lower strut bolt and nut using a 18mm wrench and socket. Seat the splines of the bolt into the strut. **See Photo 12.**









- 15. Place the sway link into the strut mount. Secure using the OE nut and tighten using an 18mm socket. See Photo 13.
- 16. Place the ABS wire into the lower strut mount. See Photo 14.






- 17. Remove the upper ABS line clip from the OE strut. Install the clip into the upper sway link mount and secure the ABS line in the clip. **See Photo 15.**
- 18. Place the lower ABS line into the lower strut mount. See Photo 16.





- 19. Tighten the upper strut bolts using a 12mm socket. See Photo 17.
- 20. Install the wheels and tires on the front of the vehicle.
- 21. Using a jack, lift the front of the vehicle and remove the jack stands and lower the vehicle onto the ground.



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
